Guarding Your Heart When You've Been Betrayed 1 Samuel 23; Psalm 54

• Keep Godly relationships active.

1 Samuel 23:16 (NIV) - And Saul's son Jonathan went to David at Horesh and helped him find strength in God.

David had the sense to trust who Jonathan was over who Saul wasn't.

Because David gave Jonathan space to speak into his life, he gained the perspective he needed to respond with wisdom to the betrayal he felt.

• Trust God as your vindicator and leave justice up to Him.

Psalm 54:1 (NIV) - Save me, O God, by your name; vindicate me by your might.

God will do better for you, better by you, better on your behalf than you'll ever do for yourself.

• Celebrate with confidence that God will do what is right.

Psalm 54:6-7 (NIV) - I will sacrifice a freewill offering to you; I will praise your name, Lord, for it is good. You have delivered me from all my troubles, and my eyes have looked in triumph on my foes.
